



VOTE CHILD CARE

There is a federal election on October 21st. We need candidates to commit support for the Affordable Child Care for All Plan, which proposes concrete measures to make child care:

Affordable – Child care fees are the first or second highest expense for households with young children. The cost can be brought down with more public funding of child care services.

High-quality – Quality of programs depends on qualified early childhood educators and other staff. To recruit and retain qualified educators, public funding must be directed at improving their compensation and professional development.

Available and inclusive – Canada needs more licensed child care programs so that those who want child care can find it where and when they need it. The expansion of child care must be publicly-manage. Leaving it to the “market” to decide where or what kind of services are offered means many will never have access to the services they need.
